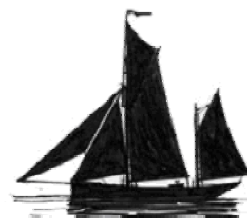


BRIXHAM HERITAGE REGATTA 2010



Organising Authority : Brixham Yacht Club

This event will be held from Friday 28th to Sunday 30th May 2010 and is open to all boats over 30 years old (Classic).
The Regatta is divided into 6 classes :

- Class 1 Sailing Trawlers
- Class 2 Gaff rigged & Lugger working boats , from 30 to 60 feet & replicas
- Class 3 Small working boats and derivatives, up to 30 feet & replicas
- Class 4 Classic gaff rigged yachts & replicas
- Class 5 Other Classic wooden yachts & replicas
- Class 6 Other Classic yachts

Each class has at least one trophy to compete for and there is a Concours D'Elegance for the best presented vessels.
